

Hot Dog Roller

User Manual

1. Introduction

All models of hot dog roller are characterized by an appealing user-friendly design, durable stainless steel structure, and ease of use.

3. Product Assembly

- Unpack the glass cover carefully. Please review the parts list of the hot dog roller cover to ensure you have all parts to complete assembly.
- Begin by removing the 4
 existing screws at the top edge
 of machine. Install the 4 plastic
 brackets with the screws.
 Place the two triangle glass
 sections into the brackets carefully.
- Place the curved glass section into the back plastic brackets channel. Make sure the edges of the top and side glass are flush.
- Place the stainless steel trim plate over the edge of the top and side glass. Insert a bolt through each side of the trim plate. Secure bolts with nuts. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN as this may crack the glass.



4. Before use

- Please read instruction book carefully before using. Get to know the machine and how to operate it safely.
- It is of utmost importance to clean the glass cover and rollers with a wet soft cloth.
- Install the machine on a durable workstation. Make sure the glass cover is fastened to the brackets.
- Check voltage before connecting the power plug.

5. Operating Instructions

- Please apply edible vegetable cooking oil with a small brush to each end of heating rollers near the white plastic ring. This allows the rollers to turn smoothly.
- Turn on the power switch. Place the hot dogs onto the machine.
 Set the controller to your desired cooking temperature.
- The heating light will turn on as the element heats the rollers.
 The light will turn off once the desired temperature is reached.
- There are two heat controllers and two indicator lights. The FRONT controller heats the front 3 rollers. The REAR controller heats the rear 2 rollers.
- Turn off the machine when you are done cooking.
- The machine should be cleaned after every time use.

6. Attention

- DO NOT allow minors to use the machine.
- Keep the power cord and connector plug away from water or excessive heat. DO NOT use the machine if the cord or the plug is damaged.
- Please DO NOT move the machine while in operation.
- NEVER touch the heating rollers with your hands.
- Ensure the machines is switched off and unplugged before cleaning or performing any maintenance.
- DO NOT use any hard metallic objects to clean (including scratch pads etc.)
- Please use a warm damp cloth or other soft material to clean the machine.
